10	3 Round Beets (3" Tops)

12	3 Large Onions (3" Tops and each over 8oz)
13	3 Small Onions (under 8oz)
14	3 Courgettes
15	1 Cabbage with 3" root
16	1 Lettuce with root
17	Mini collection (4 single specimens of vegetables from classes 1-16. Displayed on a board or black cloth, not exceeding 450mm x 600mm)
18	1 Dish of Mixed Summer Fruits (minimum 9 fruits)
19	1 Bunch of Mixed Herbs
20	Children's section 9 & under and 10-14 years old. An animal made of fruit and or vegetable.

21	Sponge Cake
22	Fruit Cake
23	Decorated Cake (Judged for decoration only)
24	Up to 2 any Jam
25	Up to 2 any Chutney

Competition Rules

1. Exhibitors must enter on the official entry form no later than 4th August 2017. The forms can be found on the Council website at **www. cheadlestaffordshire.co.uk** and the Council section under 'What's on' or alternatively from the Cheadle Council's offices, The Lodge, 21 Tean Road recreation ground, ST10 1LG.
2. The cost per entry will be £0.50p and all monies raised will be donated to a local charity in Cheadle.
3. On arrival at the event, exhibitors will collect class cards from the organisers and place them face down against their exhibits.
4. Exhibitors may enter one exhibit only for each class and up to two entries for jams and chutneys.
5. Each exhibit must have been home grown or home made no shop bought products will be allowed. If the Judge believes this to be the case the exhibit will be automatically disqualified.
6. A list of ingredients must be supplied by the entrant and must accompany the cake, jam or chutney. Failure to supply the list will mean automatic disqualification.
7. All cakes, jams & chutneys will be auctioned off at the end of the competition and the proceeds will be donated to a local charity.
8. No exhibit may be removed except by an official until the official closing time.
9. Staging of the exhibits will take place from 9.00 am until 11.00 am on Sunday 6th August 2017 after which time all exhibitors will be requested to vacate the competition area.
10. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place will be allocated by the Judges whose decision is final.
